

# Understanding Your Electric Bill

1. **Account number or Invoice number** – Number used to identify you as a member.
2. **Billing Date**
3. **Total Amount due** -( includes past due if any) Past due balance due immediately
4. **G & T Factor** – is the monthly generation and transmission factor used to calculate the power supply charge. This can vary monthly.
5. **Delinquent After Date** – Date your **current charges** are due.
6. **Balance forward** – Past due balance or credit balance forwarded.
7. **Service address** – Description of the location being served.
8. **Rate** – Identifies the billing rate and class for the service location.
9. **Meter Number** - Identifies our meter at your location.
10. **Multiplier** – Utilized in metering to multiply the kWh & kW for billing.
11. **Readings Previous / Present** – Readings for current billing period, used to calculate the kWh used.
12. **kWh** – Total usage measured in kilowatts.
13. **Description of charges billed** (descriptions may vary by account)
14. **Amount of each charge**
15. **Name of account membership**
16. **Current Charges** – This amount includes your Customer charge, Wires charge and Power Supply charge for **current billing period**.
17. **Miscellaneous Charge/Credit Code** – Description of miscellaneous charges or credits, legend is printed on the back of the bill.
