

2026 Scholarship Application

The San Bernard Electric Cooperative (SBEC) scholarship program was established to encourage and assist in the educational pursuits graduating seniors who are members of SBEC and reside in the service area. Funds will be disbursed for courses of instruction at an accredited four-year university/college, junior college or TEA-approved trade school offering an associate degree.

Eligibility:

- Parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be members of San Bernard Electric Cooperative.
- Must be a graduating senior from high school. SBEC will award one scholarship to a graduating senior from
 each High School in our service territory (Bellville, Columbus, Faith Academy, Hallettsville, Hempstead,
 Magnolia, Rice, Royal, Sacred Heart, Sealy, Waller, and Weimar High School) and one scholarship to an
 accredited home extended studies program or senior who attends high school outside of those listed in our
 service territory.
- Applicant must show proof of enrollment to an academic, vocational or technical college in order to receive scholarship funds.
- The applicant must be in the top 50% of their graduating senior class.
- Scholarship application must be postmarked or emailed by midnight on Monday, March 9, 2026, to:

Selection of Recipients and Disbursement of Funds:

Recipients of the scholarships will be chosen based on the following:

Financial necessity - 30 percent
Written essay - 40 percent
Participation in community/school activities - 30 percent

The total scholarship award will be \$2,500 and will be disbursed over your first semester. Recipients must provide a copy of their fee receipt and class schedule. At that time, SBEC will pay \$2,500 in recipient's name directly to the recipient, parent, or college/school.

2026 Essay Format and Topic:

The essay will be evaluated based on the following: demonstrating an understanding of the subject matter, originality, composition, grammar and neatness. The essay should be typed, 500 words in length, 12-point font and double spaced. It should be written on the following topic:

Describe an accomplishment, event or realization and how it relates to your field of study and your future goals.

Deadline:

A completed application must be **emailed/postmarked by midnight on Monday, March 9, 2026.** Completed application (including all necessary documentation) can be submitted by e-mail, dropped off at area office, or mailed.
