Frequently asked questions about Joint Membership:

Q: Does having a joint membership mean both spouses are members and each have a vote at the annual membership meeting?

A: No, a joint membership is still considered one membership, but having the membership in both names allows either spouse to participate in the business meeting in the absence of the other.

Q: What are the advantages to having a joint membership?

A: Upon the death of either spouse of a joint membership, the account will be changed to the survivor's name, eliminating the need for a new application for service and membership fee from the survivor.

A: Upon legal separation or divorce, the membership shall continue to be held by the one who continues to directly occupy or use the premises. The account will be changed to the remaining spouse's name when legal papers have been received stating who is to continue the use of the premises and who is to receive the capital credits that have been assigned to the account.
